


GATHERING RITE ON THE WORD



FIRST READING

Deuteronomy 7:6-9

The mystery of election is beyond our understanding. God picked me? Out of all the peoples on the face of the earth, he looks at people like us in the wide-open spaces of the Dakotas, Montana, Wyoming, and Canada? It's not because we're wonderful or numerous or powerful. We are, in fact, a tiny district in number. It's because "the LORD loved you." And because he "kept the oath," his oath. It's a marvel to think that God picked and preserved churches like ours. We're barely hanging on by our fingernails in some places. We're spread out so far and so thin. And yet he looked at us with love and continues to do so.



⁶For you are a people holy to the LORD your God. The LORD your God has chosen you out of all the peoples on the face of the earth to be his people, his treasured possession. ⁷The LORD did not set his affection on you and choose you because you were more numerous than other peoples, for you were the fewest of all peoples. ⁸But it was because the LORD loved you and kept the oath he swore to your ancestors that he brought you out with a mighty hand and redeemed you from the land of slavery, from the power of Pharaoh king of Egypt. ⁹Know therefore that the LORD your God is God; he is the faithful God, keeping his covenant of love to a thousand generations of those who love him and keep his commands.

Philippians 1:3-11



And so we pray for each other, as Paul reminds us with great longing and "the affection of Christ Jesus," not always seeing each other or knowing what to pray for, but realizing that from beginning to end it's God who started and finishes the work. May the Lord keep us pure and blameless "until the day of Christ." Then, no matter how little, if ever, we see each other during the days of life, we will be joined to glorify and praise our loving God forever.

³I thank my God every time I remember you. ⁴In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with joy ⁵because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now, ⁶being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.

7It is right for me to feel this way about all of you, since I have you in my heart and, whether I am in chains or defending and confirming the gospel, all of you share in God's grace with me. 8God can testify how I long for all of you with the affection of Christ Jesus.

⁹And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight, ¹⁰so that you may be able to discern what is best and may be pure and blameless for the day of Christ, ¹¹filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ—to the glory and praise of God.

GOSPEL John 17:1, 13-26


There are times in everyone's life, and in our district, when we see how not "one" we have been. We show how much we need to be sanctified by the Spirit through the Word. We show how much protection we need from the evil one. We show how much the prayer of Jesus, "that we would be one" is more often an ideal than a reality. We show how true is our confession, that we "believe in one, holy, Christian, and apostolic Church," because we can rarely see this oneness. As we embark upon our next one-hundred years, pray the Lord Jesus to bring us closer and closer together in unity, in peace, and in love.



After Jesus said this, he looked toward heaven and prayed: "Father, the hour has come. Glorify your Son, that your Son may glorify you. ¹³"I am coming to you now, but I say these things while I am still in the world, so that they may have the full measure of my joy within them. ¹⁴I have given them your word and the world has hated them, for they are not of the world any more than I am of the world. ¹⁵My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one. ¹⁶They are not of the world, even as I am not of it. ¹⁷Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth. ¹⁸As you sent me into the world, I have sent them into the world. ¹⁹For them I sanctify myself, that they too may be truly sanctified. ²⁰"My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, ²¹that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that

the world may believe that you have sent me. ²²I have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one—
²³I in them and you in me—so that they may be brought to complete unity. Then the world will know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me. ²⁴"Father, I want those you have given me to be with me where I am, and to see my glory, the glory you have given me because you loved me before the creation of the world. ²⁵"Righteous Father, though the world does not know you, I know you, and they know that you have sent me. ²⁶I have made you known to them, and will continue to make you known in order that the love you have for me may be in them and that I myself may be in them."


